GREAT NORTHERN Profiles listed next are actually portions of the much older, larger, and nicer format, simply called "PROFILE"S, before they were "CONDENSED", originally drawn circa 1915, revised through the '20s, '30s, and '40s. These are remarkable, showing surrounding features and other details the way they were meant to be shown, similar in style to Plat Maps, with a huge, huge scale of 13" to 14" = one mile! All are in style to that maps, with a hoge, hoge scale of 15 to 14 = one fillier. All are in a stunning "whiteline" ink on blue paper, fan-folded. These are not standard continuous profiles as they are supposed to be. All have been chopped into individual blueprint maps for use when proposing track changes (shown in red ink on the maps) for the Engineering Department. Special labels indicating proposed changes have been affixed to the profile segments. While the work to be done on each map may sound insignificant, many of the profiles below show several miles of very well-detailed trackage and surrounding vicinities. "(#x)" indicates more than one of the same profile is available for sale. All are mint or near mint, and come from a First Class collection of very old GN maps. GRAND TRUNK track charts listed next column for 1972 and 1986 are the VERY best! They are the official "Maintenance Program & Track Chart", printed in blueline ink, on continuous fan-fold paper. Beautiful detail, with front & back light-blue card-stock covers. Hand-printed on the covers are very nicely-made GT logos, the title, the division covered, and the name of the men who owned them; a Mr. Donald G. Wooden, Grand Trunk's Vice President of Corporate Planning & Finance for the ones from 1972, and W.H. Dempsey for the 1986 edition.

NP 1923 YELLOWSTONE DIV: GLENDIVE -

NICHOLS "PROFILE" SET: Seven very long scrolls are in this rare set of old NP profiles, covering the majority of the Yellowstone Div. Main Line between Glendive, MT and Billings, MT, stopping short of Billings at Nichols. These are in the older, more desirable "Profile" format, before they were "Condensed" in later years. Phenomenal plat-map detail with a huge scale of 13.25 inches = one mile! Scroll #1 covers m.p. 21-40, then 40-60 in the next scroll, 60-80, 80-100, 100-

They are comb-bound, with black cardstock covers, and professionally labeled on each edition. Some may not be complete divisions. Priced accordingly.
